

International Summer School on German Criminal Law with a Special Focus on Medical Criminal Law

July 31st- Aug. 4th 2017, University of Würzburg, Germany



The Summer School Würzburg offers a high level of tuition on the structures of German Criminal Law and Medical Criminal Law. It has an international scope in respect of teaching content, as well as participants. The course consists of a series of daily morning lectures by Prof. Dr. Dr. Eric Hilgendorf, chairman of the Department of Criminal Law, as well as case studies and complementary teaching in the afternoons. Beside the course programme, there will be time to explore the city of Würzburg and its surroundings.

# Focal areas of the Course:

- 1. The German Criminal System: General Part and Specific Part
- 2. Informed Consent in Medical Criminal Law
- 3. Euthanasia in Criminal Law
- 4. Abortion and the Protection of Embryos
- 5. New Horizons in Medical Criminal Law

# Language & Participants:

The course will be held in English and is provided for advanced students of law / Ph.D. students.

# Arrival & Departure:

Participants are requested to arrive at the latest by the afternoon of <u>Sunday</u>, July 30<sup>th</sup> 2017, and to stay in Würzburg until the morning of <u>Saturday</u>, Aug. 5<sup>th</sup> 2017. All students are expected to make their own travel and accommodation arrangements.

# Costs:

The course is free of charge for all participants. The costs for flight, accommodation, meals and an optional day trip to the city of Nuremberg (Saturday, Aug.5<sup>th</sup>) have to be paid privately.

**Requirements:** For the time of the Summer School participants have to matriculate at the Law Faculty of the University of Würzburg.
